Hello,

Please be advised we have issued Version 2 of the Community Consultation Plan (CCP). A copy is attached and it can also be viewed on the Hanson Bunyip North Quarry webpage at http://www.hanson.com.au/About/Regulatory-Information/Projects/Bunyip-North-Quarry-EES.

The CCP outlines the consultation proposed as part of the Environment Effects Statement (EES) process according to the procedures and requirements as set out in the Ministerial Guidelines for assessment of environmental effects under the *Environmental Effects Act 1978*.

Version 2 has been updated to include information and data received since printing Version 1 of the CCP in June 2017, as well as comments provided by the community.

The Social Impact Assessment has commenced and on page 12 under the heading **2.3 Culturally and Linguistically Diverse Communities (CALD)** additional data has been included. Primarily, the study identified that 90.9% of residents of Bunyip, Bunyip North, Garfield, Garfield North and Tonimbuk were born in Australia and only and 0.17% of the local population report that they speak English 'not well' or 'not at all'.

On page 13, an updated and more easily read map highlights the *Identified Residential Dwellings in proximity* to *Project Location*.

Since the release of the CCP Version 1 and conduct of the Open House in July 2017, we have received comments from some community members indicating their unwillingness to engage with Hanson or our specialist consultants. To ensure the community has a full understanding of Hanson's requirement to respond to the procedures set out in the Ministerial Guidelines, we have included additional information on page 25 under **3.3 Issues Management**. To ensure your issues or concerns are registered and available to the Department of Environment, Land, Water and Planning (DELWP), we encourage you to participate fully in the consultation process.
