Project Timeline

The timeline for the delivery of the Environment Effects Statement for the project has been deferred by six months. The Department of Environment, Land, Water and Planning (DELWP) as well as the Technical reference Committee (TRG) has been notified of the deferment. Hanson will be utilising this time to update resource information, develop additional details on operating plant options and conceptual staging for quarry development.

Following confirmation of these project elements the final phase of a number of technical studies will commence. To date, technical work has predominantly involved the collection of background information to understand the site and existing environment.

The Bunyip North Project Schedule has been updated and attached for your information based on the revised timelines. Hanson will continue to meet with community members and engage with various organisations. However the next community information session will now be conducted in early 2019.


As per the Community Consultation Plan, Hanson has continued to engage directly with local residents as well as meet with local community groups and organisations.

Other news

While Hanson staff and specialist consultants have been undertaking study investigations, management of the site is continuing. Hanson has appointed an additional contractor to ensure weed management of the land is maintained and conducted regularly in accordance with Shire of Cardinia environmental regulations.

Hanson intends to commence planting of trees and shrubs in the buffer zone along Sanders Road. Planting this area now will ensure that, should the quarry be approved, vegetation around the site is well established by the time the proposed quarry is under construction and operational.
