

Project Timeline

As advised in Project Update #10, the project schedule for the Group 2 studies has been pushed back by six months. The time extension was triggered by the requirement for Hanson to confirm the location of the proposed operating plant, and to ensure stability of the ground upon which the operating plant will be located.

Drilling Program

The first round of drilling works to confirm the location of the operating plant was undertaken in May, and further drilling works will be undertaken in September. Below is an image of the site with the locations of where drilling is to be undertaken are identified.

The drilling works will be carried out in compliance with the *Environment Protection Act* 1970, and its associated regulations, by a professional drilling firm that operates under a comprehensive HSE (health, safety and environment) management system.

Further, although not required by regulation, Hanson has engaged a third party noise consultant to monitor the drilling program and ensure compliance at all times.

Drilling will be undertaken from Monday 10 September 2018 and will be completed by Friday 5 October 2018. The drilling team will be present Monday to Friday between the hours of 7:00am and 5:00pm, although drilling may not necessarily commence at 7:00am as prestart procedures will be taking place.

Technical Studies

During the past few months, Hanson's specialist consultants have been undertaking field tests and assessments. In some cases, this has required specialists to visit properties in close proximity to the site. If a specialist requires access to a property to collect data to inform their particular study, the property owner will be contacted in advance, permission for access sought and an appropriate date and time established for the specialist's visit.

If you do not hear from a specialist, it does not mean that your property is not included in the study. The data being sought by the specialist may be distance or direction referenced, or relevant to a specific environmental element within a property.

Other news

A few weeks ago, Hanson regrettably accepted the resignation of Bunyip North Quarry Project Manager, Stephanie Salinas, who has been offered an opportunity she found difficult to refuse. For the past 20 months, Stephanie has led the quarry project with commitment, integrity and resolve to ensure all stakeholders, including Hanson, government agencies and the community, are engaged and informed of all stages of the project. She has guided staff and specialist consultants in the better understanding and application of regulatory requirements, and has consistently encouraged the community's involvement in all stages of the EES process.
