
BUNYIP NORTH QUARRY EES

Project Update

Open House Fact Sheet



The proposed Hanson Bunyip North Quarry as per the details within DELWP's scoping document will see the extraction of stone from the property on Sanders Road, with an estimated reserve quantity of granite of 100 million tonne and an estimated life of 80-120 years depending on market demands.

Quarry access is proposed via a private and sealed haul road through the land on the western portion of the Tonimbuk Equestrian Centre. The Equestrian Centre activities are expected to continue as usual, as a separate operational facility to the quarry, if the project is approved.

The internal haul road will meet the public road way at Bunyip-Tonimbuk Road. Sanders Road is not proposed as a traffic route for quarry operations. The processing plant equipment has been located at a low point on the southern portion of Sanders Road, based on controlling visual and amenity impacts. The studies will assess the plant location suitability.

Technical studies will also assess alternate locations for the plant location, quarry staging and road use throughout the EES process. Areas of study as defined by DELWP include Resource Development, Biodiversity, Water, Cultural Heritage, Traffic and Transport, Environmental Quality, Safety and Amenity, Social Impact and Land Use, Landscape and Visual and Recreational Values.

The draft scoping requirements for the proposed Bunyip North Quarry were released by the Department on Wednesday 19 July 2017 and are open for public comment for 15 business days before the final scoping requirements are published.

Hanson, as outlined in the EES Community Consultation Plan which was also released on 19 July 2017, is committed to ensuring the community has all the information required to prepare a submission to the Department.

Environmental Effects Statement (EES) process

The process under this Act is not an approval process itself, rather it enables statutory decision-makers (Ministers, local government and statutory authorities) to make decisions about whether a project with potentially significant environmental effects should The Department proceed. coordinates the process, implementing the Ministerial Guidelines that set out the processes and requirements under the Act.

The matters to be investigated and documented in an EES are out in the 'scoping requirements' issued by the scoping Minister. Draft requirements are prepared following input from Hanson and other agencies including the Department of Economic Development, Transport, Jobs **Aboriginal** and Resources, Victoria, EPA Victoria, Shire of Cardinia, Heritage Victoria, Melbourne Water, Southern Rural Water and VicRoads.
