	as the subdivision is developed closer to the	
	quarry. SB explained that the closest resident	
	may be only 300m away from the pit. SW gave a	
	brief description of ground vibration and blast	
	overpressure and explained that the quarry was currently establishing "site laws" to ensure the	
	quarry remains below the limits as per the	
	Project Approval.

8.4	LD made the point that the public can be	
	uncertain about the quarry and that speculation	
	can lead to rumours, particularly about the end	
	of the quarry's life.	
2.5	The group briefly discussed the potential for a	
8.5	fact sheet that could summarise current and	
	future operations. It could be made available at	
	prominent locations in the community such as	
	Killalea, the Links and the marina precinct in the	
	future.

The group briefly discussed water management particularly as the pit will be developed below sea level. VS asked if there were any other coastal quarries in Australia that operate below sea level.
