What we do at Bass Point Quarry

The site has been used for extractive industry since 1880, and recent use of the site has been established in 1960s.

- The quarry has approval to operate until 2044.
- The quarry supplies a range of products for projects like building railways, roads, bridges, dams, airports, harbours, houses, hospitals, schools and shopping centres.
- The quarry employs around 70 local people in various roles. We also require a constant stream of local contractors that supply services and goods to keep the quarry running. Another 30 years of quarry life is great for employee security but also for local businesses.

Hanson Bass Point Quarry has an established relationship with the local Shellharbour community.
