# ITEM 6: Operations update

- JB discussion of restructure within Hanson. Changes in operations at Moolong allowed for a combination of both QM roles at Moolong and EG. Chris has received his Mines Competency Certificate and is able to manage at any quarry within Australia.
- Trucks start at 5:30am and staff are generally on 12 hour shifts. Weighbridge Operator and Josh start at 5:30am with plant start at 6pm. Discussion around number of staff in the office and at the plant no changes to general staff, only management.

- Sales forecast 280,000 tonnes finish 330-350,000 tonnes at the end of the year (20<sup>th</sup> Dec).
   2020 volumes forecast 380,000t.
- Stockpiles dust/man sand 14,000t.

### Blasting

- 11 blasts for the year. 12<sup>th</sup> to be blast 3<sup>rd</sup> December. One exceedance of 119.4 dBL (air blast overpressure), weather effected.
- Mitigation no blasts on Mondays, allows for better organisation RE: weather tracking.
- Blast notification email notification 10 neighbours have approved, 4 neighbours still on letterbox drop.

# **Water Discharge**

- No discharge in 2019.
- Solar bore 44.4ML since 2017.
- GW report shown (REQUEST send copies to CCC graph and report)
- All data provided to CCC members.

#### Noise

 Attended noise monitoring – discussion around reduction of noise monitoring frequency requirements, generally accepted by CCC members. Further investigation required around DPIE and EPA requirements.

#### Dust

- Discussion of Dust Deposition Gauge results rolling average has been compliant for the year.
- Discussion of DustTrak unit (PM<sub>10</sub> monitor) issues through the year.
